## Three Pillars of Membership



### 1. Talent Acquisition

#### THE PIPELINE

**Problem:** Traditional hiring is broken. Resumes can't prove prompt engineering skills.

**Advantage:** Bypass recruiters. Access GitHub repos and competition logs of "Architect" track winners. You hold "First Right of Refusal" for interviews.



### 2. Workforce Resilience

#### THE DEFENSE

**Problem:** Employees are using AI secretly and insecurely (Shadow AI).

**Advantage:** Includes 100-seat Enterprise License for "Applied AI Foundations." We train on privacy, prompt injection, and automation.



### 3. Strategic Governance

#### THE OFFENSE

**Problem:** Standards are being written without your input.

**Advantage:** You sit on the committee defining the "Standard of Excellence." The competition challenges solve *your* business problems.

# The Operational Protocol

We understand executive time scarcity. The Board is designed with a "Delegate System" to ensure value capture without CEO bottleneck.



### The Principal (You)

Holds the title, the recognition, and attends the Annual In-Person Summit.



### The Delegate (CoS / VP)

Manages execution, assigns training licenses, and attends quarterly briefs.
